

CURRICULUM VITAE (CV). Serhat Köksal

2/5BZ, aka Serhat Köksal has worked as a multimedia artist with various releases in video, music and literary formats since 1991. He has performed live audiovisual performances in 91 cities and 20 countries. The venues he has participated in are festivals, art spaces, clubs and exhibitions in North America, Europa and Asia. In addition to that, he did numerous solo and participating exhibitions. He has worked as a curator organizing exhibitions, as a radio producer/DJ with monthly radio programs. He gives workshops and performed audio and video works at universities and sells its own conceptual music productions in various countries. Furthermore, he composes music for films and is a musical and art adviser to documentary films.

Serhat Köksal also had a vivid media presence: In 1994 he has been interviewed by legendary radio host [John Peel](#) for the BBC World Service and participated two times at the "Peel Session" at BBC Radio 1. He has been interviewed by Channel 4 Tv for the Mondo Macabro television series in 2001 about Turkish Pop Cinema. In 2006 he has been selected in the first wide-ranging book about audio visual art and VJ culture (D-Fuse). Later in 2013 and 2022, he has been interviewed by ARTE TV (France and Germany) for the music programme "Tracks". Serhat co-curated and organized the International Roaming Biennial (Urban Jealousy) held in Berlin, Istanbul and Belgrade with the participation of 600 artists from all over the world and has performed his audiovisual performances at universities such as Akademie Der Künste Berlin, Filmakademie Baden-Württemberg (w/workshop), Leuphana University Lüneburg, HfBK Dresden University, Potsdam University. He has performances participated in venues such as HKW (Haus der Kulturen der Welt), Martin-Gropius-Bau, Podewil Theatre, Künstlerhaus Bethanien, Volksbühne, Melkweg, Paradiso, Leidseplein Theater, and art institutions such as ZKM (Zentrum für Kunst und Medien), IFA (Institut für Auslandsbeziehungen), ZK/U ((Zentrum für Kunst und Urbanistik) and furthermore at international art festivals such as Transmediale, CTM, World Wide Video, Sonic Acts, Donau, Claudestino, Fusion, Bozar, Rotterdam Film Festival, Diagonale Film Festival, Norient,... His works were invited to the 3 months Artist residency programs with grants in TESLA medien>kunst<labor (in collaboration with Transmediale Festival) and Künstlerhaus Bethanien in Berlin and MuseumsQuartier Wien. As a radio producer, he continues to broadcast his programs on reboot.fm Berlin, with which he has been working together since 2004 on a monthly basis and since 2021 produce his programs on monthly basis in Movement Radio within the Contemporary Cultural Institution of Onassis Stegi in Athens. Recently, in July 2022, he presented his multimedia project "Remake Exotic" by interviewing Arte TV Tracks in the documentary Planet Prison. 2023 for Artist Residency ([TRAFO](#)), Solo Exhibition and Audiovisual Performance.

2/5 BZ is a Turkish one man multimedia project created by **Serhat Köksal** in 1986, who combines traditional Turkish music, noise, ambient, big beat and numerous other stylistical references, such as collages of music, cinema, speech and field recordings. So far 2/5 BZ has performed at well-known festivals such as Club Transmediale in Berlin, collaborated with numerous musicians such as Tim Hodgkinson and a session for **John Peel** in 2003.

1. Links To Peel

Peel discovered 2/5BZ when he was making a programme about Turkish music for the **BBC World Service** in 1994, when he visited Turkey. On his show on 26 November 1994 (BFBS), Peel explains that he discovered the one man project by the cassettes he was given:

"In Turkey I picked up as always a load of cassettes and stuff and you know some interesting stuff in there, but only one really really rather astonishing recording and that's by a one man band called 2/5 BZ" 1994

and was unable to control them during the live situation (Hoffmann 2004, 93). If this example points to the complexity of combined audiovisual authorship in real-time performances, it is not meant to suggest that this complexity cannot be mastered. There are performers who successfully control both audio and video—Serhat Köksal from Istanbul, for example, VDJ Oof from Paris, or Herman Kolgen from Montreal.

Serhat Köksal has continued to develop his multimedia project 2/5 BZ, initiated in Istanbul in 1986, up until the present day, expressing himself in a wide range of media forms. Recent audiovisual performances like "NO Touristik NO Exotic", which have been shown internationally, Serhat Köksal has produced an uncountable number of tapes, CDs, video-collages, performances, stickers and Copy-Zines.

In his project "NO Pipeline NO Exotic", Serhat Köksal aka 2/5 BZ illuminates the common cultural clichés between Orient and Occident in a critical and humorous way, investigating their effects on people's economic or political situation and individual states of mind. He employs collage and cut-up techniques, found film material, outdoor shots and samples. The project concentrates on concepts such as "cultural pipeline" and "energy dialogue", presenting them with soundscapes and "stereotore" visuals.

At the opening of the exhibition, which includes a video installation and collage-wallpapers, Serhat Köksal will present his new CD/DVD "NO Exotic" within the context of an improvised live performance in collaboration with sound artist Nikolai Wiese.

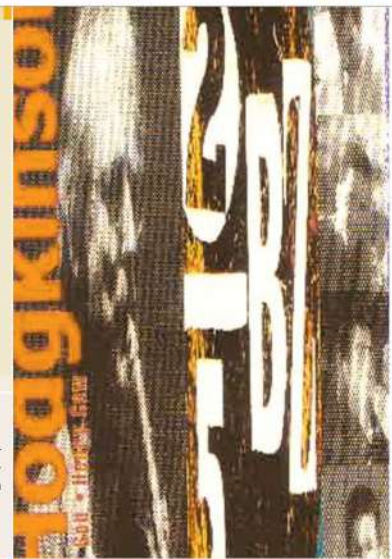

Sehr geehrte Damen und Herren,

mit diesem Brief möchte ich den weiteren Aufenthalt und Verbleib von Herrn Serhat Köksal in Berlin nachdrücklich unterstützen.

Ich bin promovierter Kunsthistoriker und arbeite seit 1995 im Bereich des Kultur- und Veranstaltungsmanagements. Gegenwärtig bin ich Wissenschaftlicher Mitarbeiter der Leuphana Universität Lüneburg und arbeite zudem als freier Kurator, oftmals in Assoziation mit dem von mir mitgegründeten gemeinnützigen Verein, Les Jardins des Pilotes e.V.. Von 2000–2007 war ich künstlerischer Leiter der "transmediale – Festival für Kunst und digitale Kultur" in Berlin, und 2005–2007 Künstlerischer Ko-Leiter des Berliner Medienkunstlabors "TESLA".

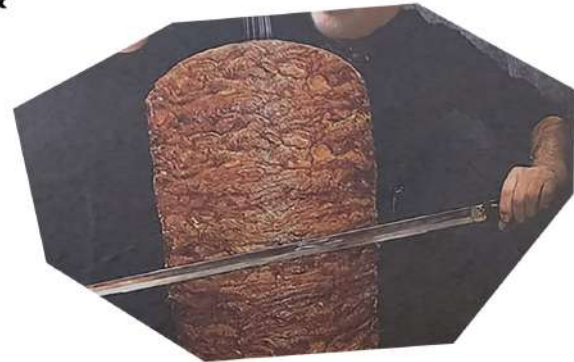

2/5 BZ or Serhat Köksal – a living legend of the Turkish underground on a monthly residency at TRAF0 Center for Contemporary Art in Szczecin. His solo show is scheduled to open at the end of June!

The legendary British journalist and BBC radio host John Peel, whose "Peel Sessions" had featured, Joy Division, The Cure, PJ Harvey and Ultravox, among others, invited Serhat Köksal to do three music sessions for his show. "Of all the music I heard in Turkey, I liked 2/5 BZ best" (John Peel, BBC World Service). Köksal's activities in the following years have remained in the cultural and political avant-garde in Turkey. According to the prestigious magazine "The Wire": "One of the first protesters to face down the riot police in Taksim Square was 2/5BZ, the pioneer of politically charged Turkish electro music and a favorite of the late John Peel".

The multimedia artist Serhat Köksal is a pioneer of the Turkish underground. He works at the intersection of visual arts and music, creating conceptual collages of sounds and images. The name of his project 2/5 BZ dates back to 1991. Fascinated by the roots and contexts of Turkish culture, Köksal began with conceptual punk art, combining electronics with the Turkish string instrument saz. He referred to the Anatolian traditions of art critical of the authorities, to Sufism, dervishes and wandering artists, 60's rock, Anatolian post-rock (Derdioyklar) as well as exuberant Kurdish wedding music. Köksal's ideological mentor was Aziz Nesin, a writer of satire, educator, social activist, the Turkish equivalent of Janusz Korczak – a man who spent most of his life in prisons, standing in opposition to the military junta and religious fundamentalists.

The visual layer of 2/5 BZ is a raw, uncompromising collage reminiscent of the aesthetic of Negativland or the video art of the American group Emergency Broadcast Network from the early 90s. In his work, Serhat Köksal incorporates fragments of Turkish trash movies, B-movies from the 70s whose characters appear in new, political contexts. The artist's flagship slogan is "No Turistik / No Egzotik". For years, Köksal has presented the meanders of contemporary Middle Eastern geopolitics to foreign audiences, playing with the stereotypes of Turkey in the Western tourist narrative. He loves to create puns such as "ISISstanbul", "Gazialism" or "Nottomanski / Sobieskullah", he processes official government announcements. Köksal had created memes long before they were invented. He comments on cultural clichés and stereotypes about the East. He deconstructs the oriental, idealized image of a tourist paradise. The message 2/5 BZ sends to the European audience makes it clear the "exotic" perception of countries such as Turkey is a manifestation of fundamental ignorance and post-colonial mentality.

A legendary example of Turkish artistic collectives is 2/5 BZ. Founded in Istanbul in 1986, the multimedia project is known for using a combination of old films, zines, tapes and computer games in its video installations. The resulting patchwork always features a strong critique of Turkish capitalism and nationalism. From the gentrification of the cities to the killing of the country's minorities, 2/5 BZ had been on the front line of activism and art in Turkey and managed to move freely, thanks to its anonymity. In 2013 it became the leading collective at the environmental protests in Istanbul's Gezi Park.

"I was one of the people in Gezi Park, the very first day the uprising went huge →

→ with millions of people around the country," 2/5 BZ wrote on the collective's Vimeo page. "During that police strike early in the morning, I was among a few people in that moment, who were being criminalised and terrorised because of their opponent positions. They wanted to bring me down, they targeted me, shot directly and consecutively towards me but could not succeed. However I fell and got injured. I have 22 titanium joints inside my shoulders. It has been two years now but the treatment and controls still goes on beside the court process."
